Suggested topics for starting a discussion or journal entry:

### #1

Within American culture there is a strong tendency toward extreme individualism as well as a tendency to be self-seeking. Discuss how today's readings and yesterday's sermons might be useful to push back against those cultural voices when we are tempted by them.

### #2

Life is complex. Even setting aside the interactions people have with each other, deep complexity appears all around nature. How might knowing God is sovereign over all the complexities of creation help us have a healthy self-estimation? How might it help interpersonal relationships?

### #3

Think about this week's hymn and about the morning service on Sunday. Is Christ your vision? When you look at the people around you and the time you are given, do you do so in the way that Christ does?

### #4

Based on today's readings, what are some good ways to use the body that God has given you? What are some bad ways? Thinking further, we know we must fight sin. How do we actually go about fighting this battle? Discuss.

### #5

As we face the end of the week, think about whether you are closer to Christ than when the week began. Discuss what you remember about last Sunday's services, and how to prepare your heart for this coming Sunday's services.
