*For Awana Clubs at Victory, all clubbers need to wear athletic shoes and clothing that fully covers from the shoulders to the knee when arms are raised: knee-length shorts or long pants and shirts that fully cover from the shoulders and collar bone to the waist (no low cut, cropped, backless, or spaghetti strap shirts). Clothes should not be overly tight or overly baggy.



Our goal is for every person who comes to grow closer to the Lord and to enjoy the Awana Clubs experience. Disruptive behavior keeps others from being able to meet that goal, so those who continually choose to be disruptive will be encouraged not to return.

Every child must participate in every part of club.

Fighting will result in an immediate suspension from club activities, a referral to the Awana Clubs Commander(s) or Pastor, and a call to parents to transport the clubber(s) home.

Repeated failure to follow club rules will result in referral to the Awana Clubs Commander(s) or the Pastor for counseling and discipline, or temporary suspension from the club.
